



Privacy statement for VdH Music Manager

VdH Music Manager treats your personal data with care. We adhere to the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We have included in this privacy statement what personal data we process and how we handle it.

Which personal data do we process?

VdH Music Manager processes personal data about you because you provide this data to us.

We process the following general personal data:

- First and last name;
- Address;
- Date of birth;
- Gender;
- Telephone number;
- E-mail address.

Why do we process your personal data?

We process your data to contact you or to provide you with more information. We also process your personal data if this is necessary for the fulfilment of an agreement or if there is a legal basis for doing so.

Retention period

VdH Music Manager does not retain personal data collected longer than necessary. We store requests for information for a maximum of one year. If an agreement has been provided, we will retain the personal data collected in that connection for a maximum of three years after the agreement has ended.

Disclosure to third parties

VdH Music Manager provides your data to singer-songwriter Michael Antony Austin if the request for information relates to him. Data is only provided to other third parties if this is necessary for the performance of an agreement, to comply with a legal obligation or if you have given your consent.

Security

VdH Music Manager ensures that your personal data is secure and that it is handled with care.

Your rights

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. To do so, you can contact VdH Music Manager by sending an e-mail to saskia@VdHmusicmanager.com. Obviously, you can't view data of other persons.

Cookies

VdH Music Manager uses cookies on its website that are necessary to display the WordPress website. Furthermore, there are cookies in use to show the Spotify plugin on the homepage. There are also third-party cookies on the website when one of the Social Media links at the bottom of the website is clicked. Of course, VdH Music Manager uses 'cookie consent' and the use of cookies can be refused. (A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit the website).
